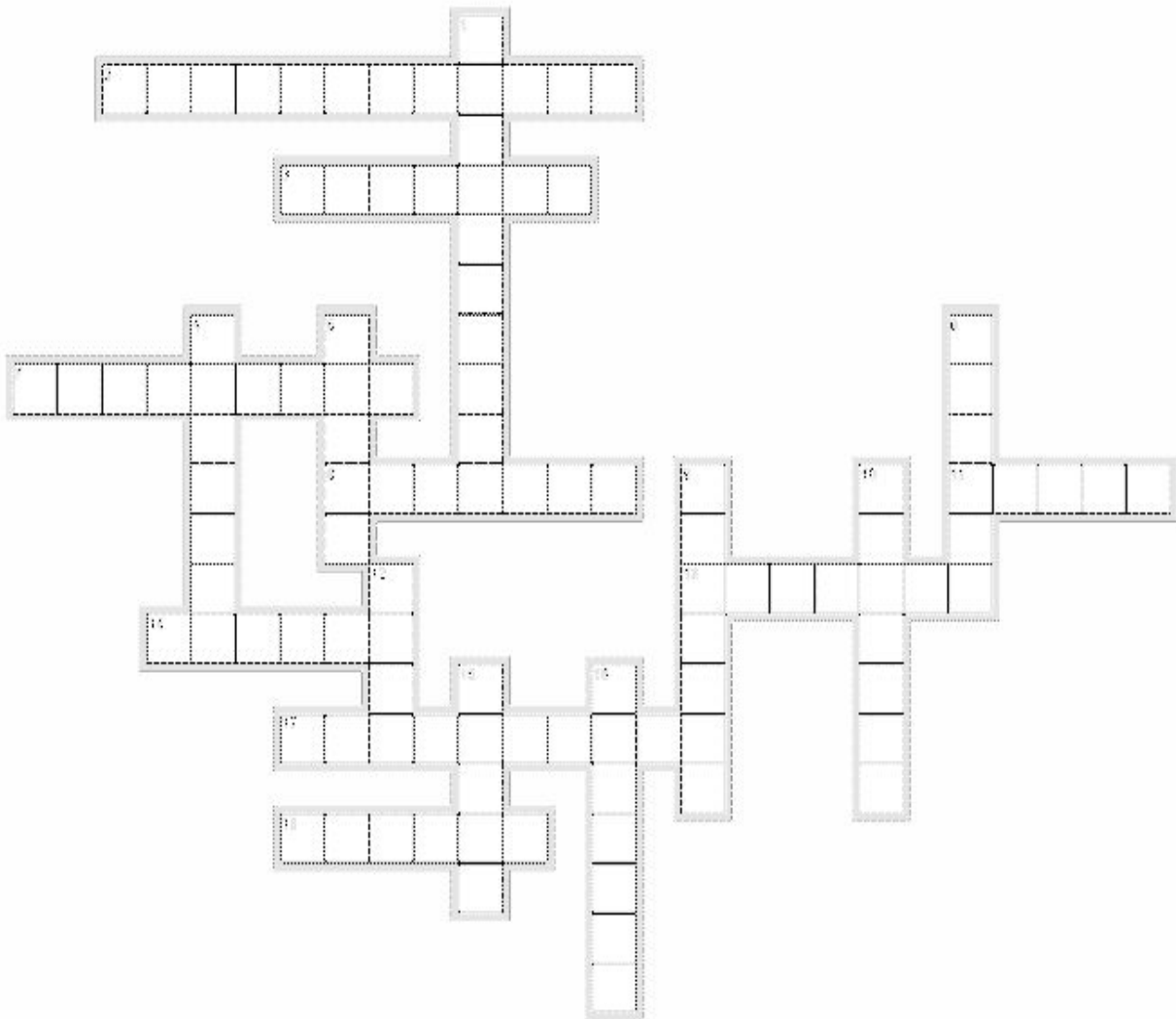


Crossword – SPORT
