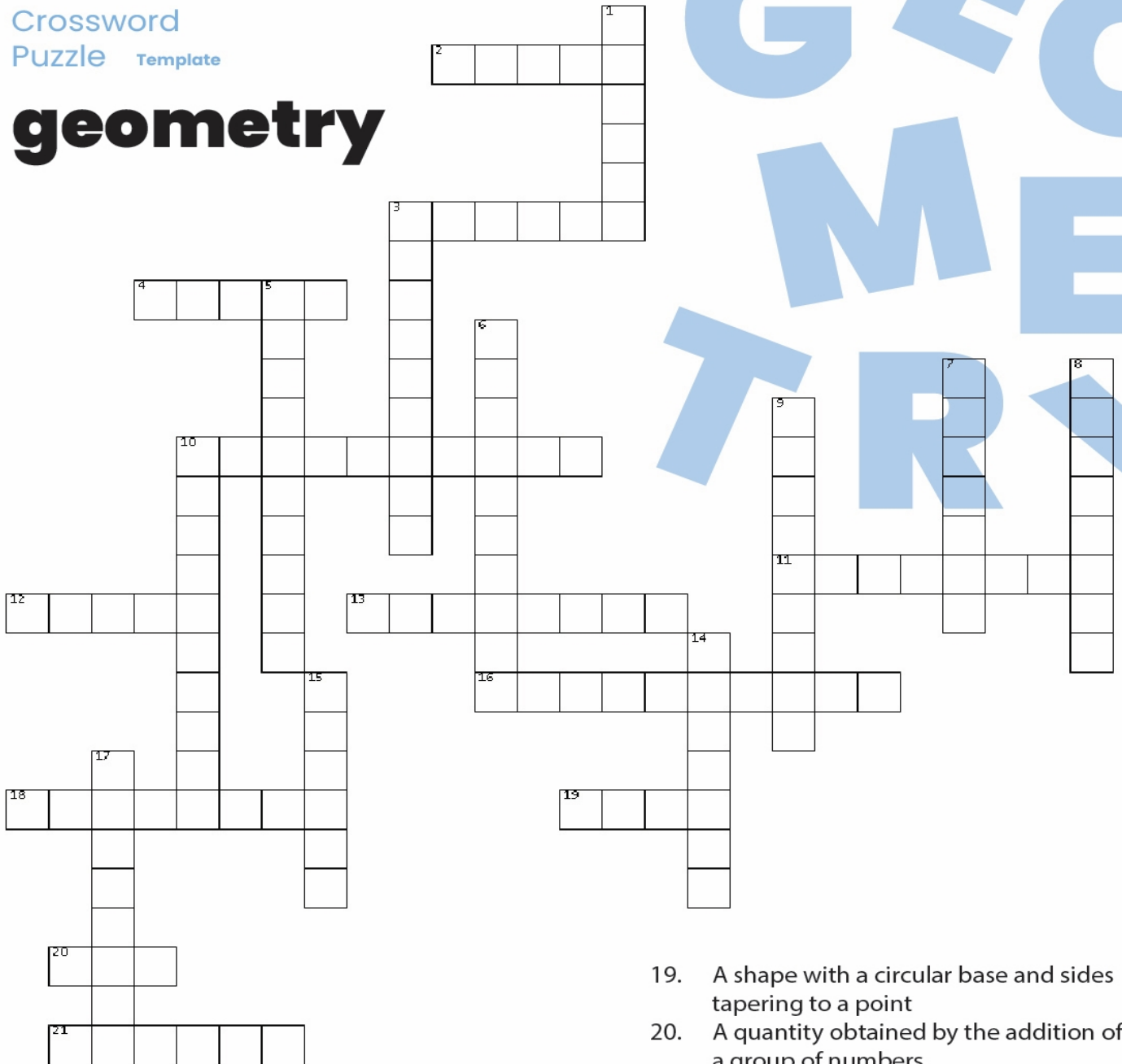

ACROSS

- The space between two lines or planes that intersect
- An area that is in the middle of some larger region
- A polyhedron with two congruent and parallel faces
- A solid figure bounded by plane polygons or faces
- A point equidistant from the ends of a line or the extremities of a figure
- Shows the relative sizes of two or more values.
- Being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting
- Being essentially comparable to something
- A surface generated by rotating a line around a fixed line

DOWN

- A particular aspect of life or activity
- Corresponding in character or kind
- The quality of being alike
- Of equal importance, rank, or degree
- A closed plane figure bounded by straight sides
- The length of a straight line through the center of a circle
- A line enclosing a plane area
- Relation with respect to comparative quantity or magnitude
- A line that touches a curve at only one point
- A specific identifiable position in a continuum or series
- Perpendicular drawn from the vertex of the triangle to the opposite side
