15. The smith of the gods and the husband of the adulterous Aphrodite.
18. God of the sea, rivers, floods, droughts, and earthquakes.
21. A Titan condemned to hold up the heavens or sky for eternity.
22. Goddess of grain, agriculture, harvest, growth, and nourishment.
23. Virgin goddess of the hearth, home, domesticity and chastity.

1. God of courage, war, bloodshed, and violence.
2. King of the underworld and the dead.
4. Virgin goddess of the hunt, wilderness, animals, the Moon and young girls.
6. The Greek god of carnal love.
7. Queen of the Underworld, wife of Hades and daughter of Demeter and Zeus.
8. He is the twice-born son of Zeus and Semele.
9. King of the gods, ruler of Mount Olympus, and god of the sky, weather, thunder, lightning, law, order, and justice.
10. God of divine distance.
13. Son of Zeus and a demi-god with superhuman strength.
14. The King of the Titans and the god of time, in particular time when viewed as a destructive, all-devouring force.
